**Sustaining & Expanding the Stock of Affordable Housing**

Since 1990, DAHC has helped the City and non-profit partners secure more than \$19.9 million for the construction or renovation of more than 669 units of housing.

**Improving Substandard Housing through the Campaign for Decent Housing**

Since 1998, the Campaign & the City together have brought more than 8,000 substandard homes up to code.

Due to the Campaign's success, the City of Durham was designated a *Certified 21st Century Challenge Community* by Habitat for Humanity.

**Helping Low and Moderate Income Home Buyers & Home Owners**

As a HUD-approved Counseling Agency since 1992, DAHC has helped thousands of families to purchase and/or sustain a home through one on one counseling sessions and first time home buyers workshops.

In 2003 DAHC helped the City create the Volunteer Minor Home Repair Program to assist low-income elderly homeowners with simple repairs. This program continues today through the administration of partner agencies.

**Public Awareness Campaign for Lead Poisoning**

As lead agency for the Community Partners Against Lead, DAHC is an advocate for housing strategies to reduce the lead poisoning of children through lead testing and trainings for lead safe work practices, cleaning techniques, and City programs.
